



GUIDANCE FOR DESSERTATION

Terms and Conditions

1. PTSI provides guidance to Students pursuing Masters' degree on a no-profit no-loss basis.
2. PTSI shall not liable to pay stipend or reimbursements to expenses incurred by the Student in any matter during the period of such guidance.
3. The Student shall approach PTSI with an appeal letter / proposal from their Guide / Head of the Department clearly stating the purpose.
4. The Student shall submit a Statement of Purpose (SOP) along with the Proposal to PTSI.
5. The discretion to select the Student for imparting guidance shall rest with PTSI.
6. PTSI shall not be liable for any kind of obligation to the Student as well as the Institution.
7. PTSI as well as Guide and Student can make use of the results, conclusions, data collected, data processed and the outcome of the research in their desired way with due acknowledgement.
8. Copyright of publishing entire work shall rest with the Student as well as PTSI.
9. The Student shall submit the finalized dissertation thesis and its references (as may be required) after examination to PTSI for its record.
10. **PTSI shall issue a Certificate on successful completion of the thesis.**
11. **The Guide / Head of the Department shall ensure that the Student submits this certificate and consider this as an important document for further evaluation.**
12. The Student shall not share or disclose certain trade secrets and vital data of PTSI without prior permission or otherwise mentioned.
13. The Student shall maintain the decorum of the office of PTSI and their interaction with other staff members shall be strictly professional as well as project oriented only.
14. The Student shall be permitted to coordinate with relevant representative of PTSI only by prior consent of concerned department Head only.
15. PTSI reserves rights to discrete or terminate the tenure duration in case the student found disobedient, and not following the company's regulations and policy.
